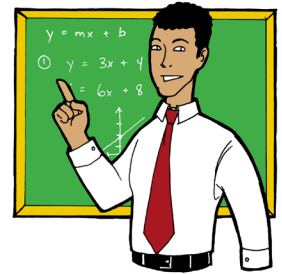


This jobs/careers fair is an annual event begun in October 2005.
